### Organist/Pianist for Music Ministry (part-time)

The ideal candidate should meet the following criteria:

- Proficiency in Various Genres of Church Music: Capable of playing classical, jazz, hymns, anthems, and contemporary Christian music on the organ and the piano.
- Excellent Sight-Reading Skills: Proficient in reading and performing complex pieces with minimal preparation.
- Collaboration Skills: Ability to work with clergy and worship team in the integration of music with the worship service. Ability to coordinate substitute and/or additional musicians when indicated.
- Commitment to Services: Availability for Sunday worship services, as well as occasional special evening services throughout the year (e.g. Ash Wednesday, Christmas Eve, Holy Week, etc.)
- Inclusive and Affirming: Comfortable serving in a church that is welcoming and affirming of people of every gender identity, gender expression, and sexual orientation, as well as individuals of every age, race, ethnicity, physical and mental ability, level of education, and family structure, and of every economic, immigration, marital, and social status.
- Alignment with Social Justice: Supportive of our church's strong commitment to social justice.
- Interest in Choir/Music Ministry Development: Experience with handbell, adult, and/or children/youth choir is not required, but is beneficial.

### Compensation:

The annual salary range for this position is \$15,500 - \$21,000 per year.

This position is part-time, with four Sundays per year as paid vacation.
